(Radio Candip, Bunia, in French 1530 GMT 25 Apr 10)

- It was reported by administrative sources that an armed group attacked a military camp at Nyaleke. Over fifty homes were set ablaze, sixteen people were injured, and seven killed. The attackers were recognized as a group comprised of the Alliance for Democratic Change from Uganda, Mai Mai fighters, and other fighters from demobilised groups.

(Radio-Television Nationale Congolaise TV, Kinshasa, in French 1230 GMT 20 Apr 10)

- A meeting was held in Gisenyi, Rwanda by the Governors of the Economic Community of Great Lake Member States (“CEPGL”) who share borders. This meeting aims to bolster joint movements to fight against the Democratic Forces for the Liberation of Rwanda (“FDLR”) and bring stability to the area. It was also decided that the border shared by DR Congo and Rwanda would be reopened.

(Radio-Television Nationale Congolaise TV, Kinshasa, in French 1230 GMT 22 Apr 10)

- Alan Doss, the UN Secretary General Special Representative in the DR Congo, has gone to Mbandaka, Equateur Province in the aftermath of the attacks on April 4 in order to support the staff of the United Nations Organization Mission in DR Congo (“MONUC”). In the course of the Enyele attack three members of MONUC were killed.
