

**DRC Domestic Radio, July 14, 2010 (Covering July 6 to July 12, 2010)**

**(Radio Candip, Bunia, in French 1530 GMT 12 Jul 10)**

- It was declared by the police inspector of Ituri District today that twelve people were killed when their vehicles were attacked by the Alliance for Democratic Front/National Army for the Liberation of Uganda close to Luna location. The travelers were heading from Bunia town to Beni location in Nord Kivu Province.
- According to the civil society of Haut Uele District several refugees are coming back to their homes in Faradje Territory from camps in South Sudan with the assistance of German NGO 'AGRO-ACTION ALLEMANDE'. It was also mentioned that over ten thousand DR Congo refugees remain in these camps.

**(Radio-Television Nationale Congolaise TV, Kinshasa, in French 1230 GMT 6 Jul 10)**

- According to Victor Makweng Kaput, Minister of Health, from the city of Sange, Sud-Kivu Province two hundred and forty-two people died and one hundred others were injured in the oil tanker explosion.

**(Radio-Television Nationale Congolaise TV, Kinshasa, in French 1230 GMT 7 Jul 10)**

- The Minister of health and the Minister of social affairs stated that they have received instruction from the Prime Minister to establish an inter-ministerial committee to coordinate relief for the victims of the oil tanker explosion on July 2 in Sange.
- The recent attacks in Kindu, Maniema Province called "katakata" have raised great concern amongst residents. The victims are receiving cuts to their hearts, kidneys, and reproductive organs. Thus far two people have been arrested in conjunction with these attacks and have been sent to court.

**(Radio Candip, Bunia, in French 1530 GMT 8 Jul 10)**

- Criticisms are being launched by administrative leaders in Aru Territory, Ituri District, at Sudan for allegedly violating the recently accepted border agreement between DR Congo and South Sudan. Allegedly the south Sudanese are continuing to build in Kimba village (which is on Congolese land) under the protection of armed members of the Sudan People's Liberation Army ("SPLA").
- It was stated today by the local administrator of Dungu Territory, Haut Uele District, that approximately one hundred and twenty girls were forced to leave the

school system in Gangalabodio area alone primarily due to pregnancy and forced marriages.

- According to administrative sources in Ituri District hundreds of internally displaced persons ("IDPs") arrived from Nord-Kivu Province in Eringeti location, Orientale Province, this afternoon. They are fleeing the ongoing violence caused by the Alliance of Democratic Forces ("ADF")/National Army for the Liberation of Uganda ("NALU") and the DR Congo Armed Forces ("FARDC") near Mount Rwenzori.

**(Radio Candip, Bunia, in French 1530 GMT 9 Jul 10)**

- It was declared by Governor Medar Autssai Asenga, Orientale Province, that he will go to Kimba location close to the South Sudanese border to verify that the South Sudanese are violating an agreement between DR Congo and Sudan to respect the DR Congo's border and territory.
- Humanitarian assistance is being requested to help the new IDPs from Luna location, near Bunia town by administrative sources in Ituri District. They are fleeing the ongoing clashes close to Mount Rwenzori between the FARDC and the ADF/NALU.
