(Radio-Television Nationale Congolaise TV, Kinshasa, in French 1230 GMT 16 Jun 10)

- The UN Organisation Mission in the Democratic Republic of Congo ("MONUC") will be called the UN Mission for Stabilization of the Democratic Republic of Congo ("MONUSCO") as of July 1, 2010.

(Radio Candip, Bunia, in French 1530 GMT 16 Jun 10)

- Approximately one hundred and fifteen Senegalese MONUC peacekeepers left for Dakar, Senegal today following a farewell ceremony in Kisangani town, DR Congo. They were all thanked for their contribution to the DR Congo by Governor Medar Autsai Asenga and the head of MONUC in DR Congo.

(Radio Candip, Bunia, in French 1530 GMT 18 Jun 10)

- The elders of the Walendu Bindi area are requesting that Colonel Cobra Matata surrender to the Armed Forces of DR Congo ("FARDC") military operational zone. They went on to say that the FARDC should attempt to detain the former warlord who could restart conflict in this location.
- According to a report from administrative sources in Dungu Territory, Haut Uele District, a faction of the Lord's Resistance Army ("LRA") attempted to attack Bamukande suburb in Dungu town. Sources indicated that the LRA had wanted to attack a girls school in this area but were forced back by FARDC resistance.

(Radio Candip, Bunia, in French 1530 GMT 20 Jun 10)

- The coordinator of the the outreach office of the International Criminal Court ("ICC") in Ituri District has said that it will meet with students and local leaders in order to raise awareness regarding the trials of DR Congolese detainees which are taking place.
- According to administrative sources in Haut Uele District the LRA launched an attack on Dungu territory (in the villages of Linakofo, Nangume, Kiliwa, Limai, and Bamukande) destroying several homes, injuring many people, and causing others to flee the area.
