(Radio Okapi website, Kinshasa, in French 2 Jun 10)

- According to police the head of Voice of the Voiceless (“VSV”), Floribert Chebeya, was found dead in his car on June 2, 2010 on Matadi road near Kinshasa. His driver, Fidele Bazana, has still not been found.
- Activist Robert Ilunga Numbi of *Friends of Nelson Mandela* indicated that: "This is the second human rights activist who has been killed ... I can say that as we move towards the elections, human rights activities are seen as a nuisance ... The murder is proof that human rights activist are not safe".

- Major Baraka Nguma of the Popular Front for Justice (“FPJC”) has been arrested to the approval and liking of activists and religious groups.

(Radio-Television Nationale Congolaise TV, Kinshasa, in French 1230 GMT 7 Jun 10)

- An insurrectional movement harassing the population of Shabunda territory, Sud-Kivu Province is causing the security situation to deteriorate. The community held a meeting in Kinshasa yesterday to discuss the situation and appeal to DR Congo government for assistance.
- President Joseph Kabila, in the course of chairing the high council of defense meeting on June 5, informed the attendees that the public prosecutor was being encouraged to instigate an inquiry into the assassination of the executive chairman of VSV, Floribert Chebeya.
