(Radio-Television Nationale Congolaise TV, Kinshasa, in French 1230 GMT 24 Mar 10)

- Citizens of Kingabwa area in Limete District, Kinshasa allege that the police in the area have grossly violated human rights by committing torture and making arbitrary arrests. They have requested that the Ministry of Justice conduct an investigation.

(Radio Candip, Bunia, in French 1530 GMT 25 Mar 10)

- It has been estimated by administrative sources in Ituri District that over five thousand people have been displaced and are residing in Mutangazi forest near Bunia town. Approximately twenty people have died as a result of disease and starvation. Members of the Armed Forces of DR Congo (“FARDC”) have been assisting these people to return to their homes after being caught in the cross-fire of the recent fighting in the district.
