The president of Iran has pledged harsh retaliation against enemy if his country comes under attack: "They know that we do not have an intention to engage in acts of aggression, but they know that in case of attacking us, the Iranian nation will cut the enemies' arms," President Ahmadinezhad said in his address to the fifth conference of superior entrepreneurs in Tehran, broadcast live at 0600 GMT on state-owned English-language Press TV on 20 July.

- "On Friday [23 July], Ahmadinezhad here unveiled the truth about the new US-Zionist scenario against Iran, expressing sorrow that Russia, too, is now harmonizing with it."
- "How is it possible for Iran to produce nuclear weapons while Supreme Leader of the Islamic Revolution Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamene'i and other religious authorities have declared 'producing, stockpiling and using' weapons of mass destruction as 'haram' (forbidden in Islam)" asked Ebrahimi.

 silent about nuclear weapons stockpiled by the Zionist regime."

This, in a nutshell, is the gist of the scenario."

- "PEJAK terrorist group has managed to mobilize some of its forces and equipments to areas within the Iraqi Kurdistan," Iranian Border Guard Commander Brigadier General Hoseyn Zolfaqari was quoted by IRIB as saying on Thursday [22 July].
- As a result, the commander added, "We have [security] issues on our border with the Iraqi Kurdistan region."

 has vision impairment. The severity of the beatings was such that he had to be taken
 to a medic.
- For three days now, Nurizad has gone on a hunger strike to protest his illegal and brutal mistreatment. He has told his family that he will not be able to survive if this condition continues.

- The governor-general of Iran's Tehran Province has dismissed media reports about pollution of drinking water supplied to the capital Tehran, the Iranian official government news agency IRNA reported on 20 July.
- "People, do not pay attention to rumors about drinking water supplied to Tehran and do not worry about drinking water in Tehran," the report quoted Tamaddon as saying.
- "It is surprising that media outlets affiliated to the BBC and Europeans and Americans have taken compassion on the people of Tehran and are saying - why are you sitting around, the water in Tehran is polluted and why are you drinking such

water. These countries, according to statistics available, rank lower than our country in terms of some standards and indices regarding drinking water," Tamaddon stressed.

- White House officials have sent a message to the leadership council of the Kurdistan Workers Party [PKK] and asked the PKK officials to deploy the Monafeqin [a term used by Iranian officials and domestic media to refer to the Mojahedin-e Khalq Organization] grouplet members to Qandil mountains near Iran's border.
- According to a Fars News Agency reporter in Arbil, since the deadline for the US forces withdrawal from Iraq approaches and as the Iraqi government is determined to arrest and expel the Monafeqin grouplet members from Iraq, US officials have started a hustle with an aim to deploy the terrorist Monafeqin grouplet to the mountains bordering Iran.
- He said: A message was sent by the White House officials to the leadership council of the PKK rebels on Saturday [presumably 17 July]. In this message, they asked the PKK officials to allow the Monafeqin grouplet members to be deployed to Qandil mountains close to Iran's border.

 February 2010 on charges of acting against national security due to releasing his "Ali
 Barkhiz" song.

- The Education Basij [Basij-e amuzesh va parvaresh] thwarts the enemies' soft war and protects the future of the revolution from enemies' mischief. General Mohammadsaleh Jokar said the Basij [militia] had taken fundamental steps in line with its mission, to give depth and to fight the soft threat.
- He said "by capacitating and immunizing the education-sector society [Jame'e-ye farhangian], the level of perception of all society will rise and the enemies will no longer be able to create problems through the soft war."
- Jokar said it was very important to raise [secondary school] students' scientific level, and "by realizing this important matter the enemies will no longer be able to create an obstacle for our country, which will make notable advances."
- He states that there are to be "essential change to the defensive preparation course for students in schools, and students will become more familiar with the soft war, and identify enemies with perceptiveness."
- He said that "this year 25,000 education-sector Basijis have been sent to war zones [frontline areas of the 1980-88 war] as part of the Travellers of Light [Rahian-e nur] caravans, and "the interaction between the Basij and the education sector is very notable.""
- The deputy-head of the [Majlis] cultural committee and parliamentary representative for the people of Mashhad separately told our reporter that "the need to transfer values to the third generation of the revolution is of great importance right now, and the Education Basji can become the basis of this transfer."
- Javad Arianmanesh said "the Education Basij has a key and crucial role in transferring the values of the Islamic Republic of Iran. This institution is important in the sense that it is on the one hand the receptor of values and on the other the transmitter of values to the new generation.
- He says "we pursue three important solutions in the Student and Education-Sector Basij. The first is to build cadres for the revolution by educating competent students and providing human resources at the level of the revolution. This is pursued by various means including the Chapters of Civilization [Ayeha-ye tamaddon] plan." Colonel Hoseyn Momtahen continues: "we have not restricted the scope of our work in this respect, and this includes all those working in education as well as students.
