DR. AHMED SHAHEED United Nations Special Rapporteur on Iran

Dr. Ahmed Shaheed is an internationally-recognized expert on foreign policy, international diplomacy, democratization, and human rights reform. He has twice held the Office of Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Maldives, a position he used to strengthen the country's compliance with international human rights standards and norms. Throughout his tenure as Chief Government Spokesperson and Minister of Foreign Affairs, Shaheed was a leading advocate of a new modern country founded upon liberal democratic principles, strong human rights protections, and openness and engagement with the outside world and international human rights mechanisms.

In 2011, Dr. Shaheed was elected by the United Nations' Human Rights Council to serve as Special Rapporteur on the human rights situation in Iran. In that capacity, he has conducted path-breaking research and issued authoritative reports on that country's human rights record and compliance.
