Privately-owned media

(RNA News Agency, Kigali, July 13, 2010)

- In light of the disappearance of opposition official Kagwa Rwisereka, three employees of the publication "Umurabyo" have been arrested. Journalists Patrick Kambale and Saidath Mukakibibi are in custody over the use of Nazi memorabilia which were placed on an image of President Kagame. Uwimana, boss of the journalists, is facing four counts; genocide ideology, defaming President Kagame, ethnic hatred and undermining state programs.

State-owned media

(Radio Rwanda, Kigali, July 14, 2010)

 Directorate of Refugees and Police officers on the Uganda/Rwanda border (in the township of Nakivale) began collecting Rwandan refugees and focusing them to return to Rwanda by truck.
This removal of refugees defies the Citizenship and Immigration Act of Uganda. The Rwandan refugees expressed fear about facing persecution upon their return to Rwanda.
